

GLN works with leaders all over the world!

Since the beginning of the Global Leadership Summit, we have had women and men all over the world who have put their hand up to stand with us in taking actionable, Christian leadership to leaders globally. 20 years later, most of those who work with us are volunteers and give of their time and skills to serve the Kingdom in this way. They come from 105+ different nations and speak over 50 languages. The need is great to lead them well and to see them integrated into a global organisation.

The Plan

Once a year, right before the GLS in Chicago, we want to be able to offer to bring in leadership from every nation that stands with us globally, for the following purposes:

1. **TO CONNECT** These leaders are often leading in places that are isolated, troubled, persecuted and challenged by war, natural disasters etc. We want them to connect with us and know they are not alone.
2. **TO LEARN** from one another and from the leaders of the GLN. They learn new ways of doing things, new developments, and are given resources as needed to go back to their countries and resource others.
3. **TO GROW** as leaders and in their walk with God. By being together and attending this event, we know they will expand their influence, grow in their leadership and grow closer to God.
4. **TO BE INSPIRED** by our speakers, by other leaders and by the incredible presence of God amongst people from all nations. We will worship and teach them in a way, that ignites transformation.



The Need

To bring in 500+ global leaders, there are many factors involved that need funding and resourcing. Some are able to cover their costs if they are from more affluent countries and ministries. For many of our partners on the ground, this is just not possible.

We need to provide flights for some who cannot afford them, visas, accommodation, food, venue hire, catering for the event, speaker honorariums, network launches etc
